



#### **Content Tags**

Content tags will typically adorn artist or album images. Some cases may use them directly on a card, like on LiveLyrics.

Tags are usually aligned to the **edges** of their container.



Tags appearing at the **top** or **bottom** of a container **with radiused corners**, such as a standard card, are offset from the edge by the radius + 1pt.

This would be 3pt on a normal card: 2pt radius + 1pt.



#### **Content Tags - Appearance**

Content tags will typically adorn artist or album images. Some cases may use them directly on a card, like on LiveLyrics.

A tag should be 15pt high with these values.



### **Card Bumper**


These are appended to the bottom of regular cards. The label and logo are a click target.





### **Card Bumper with Right Image Cards**

If a bumper appears under any Right Image Card the Standard Divider is set in the content area to the *left* of the image, not the entire bumper.



Standard Divider: Confined to the content area, not the bumper area.

#### **Track Title Card - Metrics**

The track title card is a non-standard card.




If some actions are unavailable the buttons collapse to their left alignment.

The iTMS button remains in place.





Bright Tag: "LIVELYRICS®" (Superscript "®") Appears over the lyrics text.



### **Static Lyrics Card**



### **Large Video Card**

The large video card usually appears attached above the video tile card. In rare cases it may appear alone.

Entire card: 198pt tall




#### **Video Tile Card**

The video tile card presents video links in a horizontally-scrolling row. Scrolling should snap to the tile edges.



#### **Video Tile Card - Tile Details**

Each tile has a drop shadow.

Each tile <u>without</u> the drop shadow: 173x120pt

Each tile with the drop shadow: 175x122pt

Each tile has a shadow:
10% brightness (#1a1a1a)
100% opacity
1pt offset down
1.5pt radius/blur (2pt may be used if sub-points can't be specified,

but the tile area will grow slightly.)


Tile corners:

A tile's top corners are square.

The bottom corners use the standard card radius of 2pt.

#### **Combined Video Card**

The video cards can be joined to present one large statically-positioned video and a series of scrolling video tiles.

## **Standard Cards**

#### **Labeled Icon Card: Small**

This simple card is typically used for premium rows, but should be available for other uses. The entire row is a target.

#### Single labeled icon row: 44pt tall



### **Labeled Icon Card: Multiple Rows**

Multiple labeled icon rows stack with a standard divider between them.



#### **Labeled Icon Card: Multiple Rows + Header**

Generic card headers can be attached to labeled icon rows, such as for event listings.

#### **Labeled Icon Card: Large**


This card is typically used for premium rows beyond the top of the page. The image, second line of text, and link arrow are all optional. The entire row is a target.



Single line label: Search music in your car


### **Labeled Icon Card: Large - No Icon**

If there is no icon provided then the labels shall expand left to fill the empty space. All other values remain the same. The link arrow remains optional.




### **Right Image Card: Small**

This layout places a small image on the right. It is used for broadcast ID and promotional offer cards. The entire card is a touch target.



### **Right Image Card: Medium**


This layout places a medium (1/3rd width) image on the right. It is used for artist, feature, and location cards. The entire card is a touch target.



Description Area:
Different layouts can fill this area depending on the card's purpose. See the following pages for examples.

### **Right Image Card: Medium - Location**


The Location card uses different text styles and images based on the message.



### **Right Image Card: Medium - Artist**

The artist card displays various content in the description area depending on their availability. Social updates (Twitter/FB) or biography excerpts are typically used. Biography excerpts use the normal *Card Subtitle* styling.

### **Top Image Card**


This simple card is used for promotions and features such as custom charts. It should adapt to the size of the top image.

### **Album Tile Card**

The album tile card presents albums in a horizontally-scrolling row. Scrolling should snap to the tile edges. This card is nearly identical to the video tile card.




### **Album Tile Card - See All Tile**

A list of albums with a detail screen places a "See All" link as the last tile.




# **Album Tile Card - Single Album**

A single album list places one tile in the center of the card. No header link or "See All" tile is used.




# **Multiple Artists Card**

If a track has multiple artists credited they are credited in this card. Each row is a touch target. If there are more than two artists then the two-line header is used with the artist count and a link to a detail list screen with all artists.




# **Multiple Artists Card - Linked Header**

If there are more than two artists then the two-line header is used with the artist count and a link to a detail list screen with all artists.



## **Song List Card**


A list of songs as used in cards like Recommended Songs.

The card shrinks to accommodate shorter images.




### **Chart Card: Standard Rows**

## **Chart Card: Highlighted Row**


A highlighted row style for chart cards, usually used to show the current track's or artist's place on a chart.




## **Chart Card: Highlighted Row - Dividers**

A highlighted row style for chart cards, usually used to show the current track's or artist's place on a chart.

Standard dividers are used between standard rows.



No dividers are used adjacent to highlighted rows.



A special divider is used if the highlighted row is out of sequence with adjacent rows.




Chart Heavy Divider **TBD**The divider's margins use the same background as the highlighted row.

The track title card is a non-standard card.



### **Right Image Card: Medium - Artist (old)**

The artist card displays various content in the description area depending on their availability. Social updates (Twitter/FB) or biography excerpts are typically used. Biography excerpts use the normal *Card Subtitle* styling.
